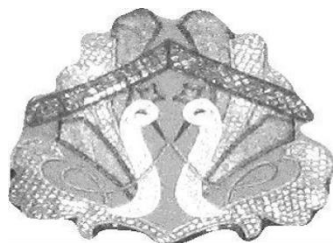

- When necessary, competitions with very few entries will be combined.
- Dancers will line up downstairs in the cafeteria 15 minutes before the competition begins.

- Entry fee must be paid at time of entry. Unpaid entry will be deleted immediately.
